Income Security Program

Old Age Security (OAS)

- A monthly pension payable to all eligible persons.
- To receive OAS, you must meet the residency requirements and be over 65.
- Monthly cheques are tied to the cost-of-living index.
- To avoid any delays in receiving benefits you can apply as soon as you turn 64.

Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS)

- This is a program that ensures that every senior has a guaranteed minimum income.
- Based on previous year's income. If married or living in a common-law relationship, the combined income of the pensioner and spouse must be taken into account.
- This is not taxable income.

Allowance

- The Allowance is paid to the spouse or common-law partner of an Old Age Security pensioner.
- It is paid on an income-tested basis to applicants who are 60-65 and have the required legal residence in Canada.
- The is not a taxable income.
- On death of the pensioner, the Allowance will be continued, based on the survivor's income, until age 65 (you must re-apply annually)

Allowance for the Survivor

- If you are a widow or widower, you may qualify for an Allowance for the Survivor.
- The benefit is paid on an income test to applicants who are 60 to 64 and have the required legal residence in Canada.
- This is not a taxable income.

Canada Pension Plan (CPP)

Retirement Pension

- The CPP is a monthly payment for people who have contributed to the Canada Pension Plan and are at least 60 years of age.
- Your retirement pension is based on how much and for how long you contributed to the Plan.
- You must apply for your retirement pension 6 months prior to when you wish the benefit to begin.

Pension Sharing

If you are married or in a common-law relationship, you may be able to save on income tax by pension sharing. If you and your spouse/common-law partner are both at least 60, you can apply to share your CPP retirement pensions equally. Both must be at least 60 and have applied for any CPP pensions to which they are entitled.

Credit Splitting

If you are separated or divorced, CPP contributions made by you or your spouse/common-law partner can be divided equally. This division applies to contributions you both made during your marriage or common-law relationship. You may be entitled to retirement, disability, or other benefits higher than those for which you would qualify on your own.

Disability Benefit

- Disability benefits are payable to disabled contributors who have paid into the Plan for the required number of years, are disabled within the meaning of the Plan and are under age 65.
- The CPP Disability benefit includes a fixed amount, plus an amount based on how much an individual has contributed to the CPP.
- These benefits are converted to retirement pensions at age 65.

Death Benefit

- A lump sum payment to the estate of deceased contributors.

Survivor's Benefit

- A monthly benefit payable to the surviving spouse or common-law partner of the deceased contributor.
- The amount depends on the age of the surviving spouse or common-law partner and the contributions of the deceased.

A quarterly income supplement is available to eligible Manitobans who are:

- 55 and over, not receiving Old Age Security program benefits and have an income within a specified range (an annual application is required); or
- Receiving certain levels of Federal Guaranteed Income Supplement or Spouse's Allowance Benefits under the Old Age Security Program. In this case, an application is not necessary as benefits are paid based on the application for federal benefits.
